Another settlement in Massachusetts as it is now called was only of a temporary nature. The granting of Charters by King James I was the first impetus to colonisation. The outcome of the King s action was the formation of two Chartered Companies, the London, and the Plymouth, which were to be governed by councils appointed by the King but were allowed to appoint colonial councils of 13 with powers that were really absolute.
